Big News

After many months of debate, legal assistance, architecture & engineering revision, and various other hurdles, we won our permit to install an elevator at the Scottish Rite Temple without any encumbrances or revisions to the parking lot properties. The costs, though significant, have resulted in a quality project.

Unfortunately, during those delays we were unwilling to campaign for financial support of this often started, never realized, project. We understood why many members' wanted to see if it was another false start – or really going to happen this time. The work did get started and is well on its way to completion; even though unknown conditions put us behind our projected schedule.

The Valley is pleased to report that our elevator assembly is in Shindler Co.'s Eagan warehouse. Now that the building is watertight and the stairs and floor are being formed, the elevator car can be installed. Shindler has informed us that it will take about two weeks for installation. Once the elevator equipment is in, low (alarm) and high voltage electrical will be integrated and interior finishing completed.

One nice fact to report; the City building inspector just did a progress review. He said that the project is progressing as required, and then complemented us on work completed. We will be riding up and down this year, and look forward to the renewed fellowship of Brothers who have been unable to attend due to the stairs.

Now; here's the challenge. Procedural issues and unknown structural conditions inherent in updating a historic building didn't maintain/build momentum toward a fundraising kick-off day. With no formal drive, members seem reluctant to give their pledges. We've gone to the "inside" well about as much as we should, and now ask our members to take a look in the mirror and see if there is not a way to make another (or


maybe your first) contribution to this most important and useful addition to our fraternity.

We will enter the lot along Hennepin Avenue, and exit only on Dupont Avenue. This "one way" parking flow should be safer for members and guests.
